A lab can upload a list IDs for authorized personnel onto a Code device each day.

- JavaScript on the device can then parse the list of personnel ID badge data.
- A badge scan determines access.

Through JavaScript programming, Code devices will force a manufacturing workflow for quality:

1. Each work step starts with a barcode scan.
2. Skipped steps get a "failed scan" alert, forcing the worker to re-visit the sequence.
3. Successful scans indicate the proper sequence.



Extra Shifts

The CR2700 Barcode Reader has two top-mount buttons to meet different needs with JavaScript.

To save on costs, hospitals often program:

- One button for medication administration.
- The other for specimen tracking.
